

Airline Travel Information

- Due to increased Security measures, airlines suggest that you arrive at least 90 minutes before departure.
- Photo ID is required at Check-in and before boarding the plane. (The photo identification must be current and government issued; such as driver's license or passport.)
- All airlines are required to 100% screening of all passenger baggage.
- When checking any luggage, be sure your name and contact information is on the outside and inside of each item.

*Pool Cues & Cases **are not allowed** as a carry-on item. They must be checked-in, as luggage, prior to boarding your flight.*

Here are some suggestions for traveling with your cue(s):

- *Bubble-wrap your case(s) with cue(s) enclosed in a box that you can check through as luggage. Sealed boxes that are checked-in are not required to be opened. They will be screened prior to being placed on the airplane.*
- *Check-in your cue case(s) as luggage, but bubble-wrap cue(s) separately in your clothing luggage.*
- *Bubble-wrap your case(s) and cue(s) in your clothing luggage.*



- Federal Carry-On rules allow one standard-size carry-on bag and one personal item. That personal item is limited to:
Purses, Briefcase, Laptop computer, Small bookbag style backpack.

Other items allowed beyond these restrictions are:

- Coats or wraps
- Safety seats for children
- Books or newspapers
- Small bags of food that is consumable
- Disk player or similar sized personal entertainment item
- Assistive devices such as wheelchairs, walkers, oxygen, etc.
