- Preregistration is required.
- Entry deadline is June 28, 2010.
(Complete entry form must be received by the APA National Office.)
- No entries or changes to rosters will be allowed at the event in Las Vegas.
- No Skill Level Limit.
- Any combination of male/female teams.
- Players may only participate on one team.
- All players must be from the same League area.
- Maximum of 4 players allowed on roster.
- Teams may choose any 3 of the 4 team members to participate in each match.
- U.S. Amateur rules and format apply.
- Race-to-7 (8 games of 9-Ball and 5 games of 8-Ball)
- Players will lag; winner of lag chooses game (8-Ball or 9-Ball) or break. Once the format has been chosen, the entire set of that format must be completed before moving to the next format.
- Each individual match is worth one point. The first team to win 2 out of 3 matches wins the team match.
- Sudden Death will be implemented 2 hours and 15 minutes into a match. Each team match must be in the 3rd individual match by the 2-hours-and-15-minutes mark, or all subsequent matches become a one game race.
- The use of jump cues is allowed.
- No coaching.
- Players must have at least 10 scores 8-Ball and/or 9-Ball.
(A combination of scores from the two formats is allowed.)
If players are participating on a Masters Division roster, it is not required that they have at least 10 scores.
- Players must have played at least four times in the Spring Session in the League area the team represents. Matches played can be in either the standard 8-Ball or 9-Ball format or on a Masters Division team.
- Players must be on an active (Summer Session) APA roster in either the standard 8-Ball or 9-Ball format or on a Masters Division roster.
- Modified Single Elimination.
- Maximum field is 192 entries. (Size of board and prize money breakdown will be based on number of entries.)
- \$150 Entry Fee per team.
- 100% Payback of entry fees goes to the top 33% of the field.
- \$1.00 tables per game.
