



Frequently Asked Questions

***Note – the following information pertains ONLY to players who have qualified to play in the 2012 APA 8-Ball Classic or APA 9-Ball Shootout in Las Vegas, Nevada.**

IMPORTANT!

If you are a qualified player for the 2012 National Singles Championships in 8-Ball or 9-Ball, **DO NOT** contact the Riviera Hotel & Casino directly to make rooming reservations. When you qualified to participate in the National Singles Championships, you filled out a **Registration and Room Reservation Form**; this form was sent to our National Office and a room has already been secured for you. Please refer to your National Singles Championships FINALIST GUIDE for more info.

➤ **When are the 2012 APA National Singles Championships?**

The National Singles Championships are April 26-28, 2012, at the Riviera Hotel and Casino in Las Vegas, Nevada.

➤ **When is player registration for the National Singles Championships?**

Player Registration is on Thursday, April 26 from 8:00 AM - 2:00 PM, followed by a mandatory player's meeting at 2:30 PM. Tournament action will begin at 3:30 PM for 8-Ball and 5:00 PM for 9-Ball.

➤ **How many rooming nights do I receive for qualifying?**

Qualified players receive three (3) nights double-occupancy rooming at the Riviera as part of your qualification package. The dates of occupancy are Thursday, April 26 through, and including, Saturday, April 28. Check out is Sunday, April 29.

If you requested a specific roommate (another qualified player) on your *Registration and Room Reservation Form*, every attempt will be made to honor your request. If you did not request a specific roommate, players will be matched according to their rooming preferences (smoking room or non-smoking room, etc. if at all possible).

➤ **What if I want to room alone?**

Players wanting to room alone, with a spouse, friend, or someone other than a qualified player will be required to pay \$34.50 plus tax for each of the three nights lodging. Payment will be collected by the Riviera Hotel and Casino at the Guest Registration counter.

If you checked single occupancy on your Registration and Room Reservation form, then we have secured a single occupancy room at your request and you do not need to contact us. If you checked double occupancy rooming and want to switch to single occupancy room, please call our National Singles Championships hotline

➤ **What are the hotel check-in and check-out times?**

Hotel check-in begins at 4:00 PM and check-out is 11:00 AM.

➤ **What do I do if I want to add additional nights to my rooming and how much will it cost?**

Please call our National Singles Championships hotline at 636-625-8611 ext. 5560 and leave us a message that you would like to add additional nights rooming to your reservation. An APA representative will return your call and set this up for you. You may also request additional rooming nights by emailing us at <mailto:specialevents@poolplayers.com>.

You will be charged \$69 per night plus tax for any additional nights lodging. Payment will be collected by the Riviera Hotel and Casino at the Guest Registration counter.

➤ **Does the APA National Office make my travel arrangements?**

APA does not make travel arrangements for you. You will need to contact a travel agent or the airlines direct. We do, however, provide travel assistance money to help offset the cost of transportation. You will receive your travel assistance money at Player Registration on Thursday, April 26 between 8AM-2PM. Don't wait to make your travel arrangements – start early and shop around for the best travel deals!

➤ **How much travel assistance money will I receive and when will I receive the money?**

All travel assistance money will be paid out onsite in cash at tournament registration. The amount of travel assistance money you will receive depends on how many miles away your League Area is from Las Vegas, and you should have been notified of the amount you will receive when you won your qualifier. If you have questions regarding the amount you will receive, please contact your League Operator.

➤ **Do you post the match schedules in advance of the tournament?**

Match schedules will not be released or posted in advance – you must wait until you are onsite to find out your first scheduled match time.
